### **SELECTION OF SECTORAL OFFICERS FOR DISTRICT PROJECT OFFICES *ONLY***

#### **1) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- a) For the persons working in Government Sector to be taken on Foreign Service terms and conditions.

4.	Community Mobilization Officer	Gazetted Officers of School Education, Adult Education, Women & Child Welfare, Labour, Welfare, Revenue, Panchayat Raj & Cooperation Departments etc.

Inclusive Education Coordinator	Gazetted Officers of School Education, Adult Education, Women & Child Welfare, Labour, Welfare, Revenue, Panchayat Raj, Cooperation and Disabled Welfare Department with M.Sc. (Zoology / Botany / Psychology) (or) M.A. (Psychology) with Special Education in M.Ed. / B.Ed. / D.Ed. or 45/90 day Foundation Course in Special Education. If Gazetted Officers with the above qualifications are not available, School Assistants working in Government Schools with the above qualifications will be considered.
6.	District Planning & MIS Coordinator	Officers belonging to Planning and Statistics with computer knowledge
7.	Assistant Programme Officer	School Assistants (Mathematics / Physical Science) with MCA / PG Diploma in Computer Applications.
8.	Assistant Statistical Officer	School Assistant (Mathematics / Physical Sciences) with Diploma in Computers.

**Note :**

1. *Separate merit lists will be prepared one for Government Officers as shown in table (a) and another for the candidates shown at (b) and (c).*
2. *Persons having experience as shown at column No.5 only need to apply. Otherwise, their applications will be rejected.*
3. *For the posts at S.No.4 to 6, persons possessing professional qualifications shown at column No.4 only need to apply. If not, their applications will be rejected.*
4. *The upper age limit in case of Retired Gazetted officers shall be less than 62 years as on 01.07.2012.*
5. *The services of selected persons working with reputed NGOs / Retired Gazetted Officers will be engaged only if the Government Officers are not available. Their remuneration will be decided separately depending upon the merit and qualifications.*

## 2. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS :

- (i) Applications for the post of Sectoral Officers should be submitted in the respective District Project Offices, Rajiv Vidya Mission (SSA).
- (ii) In-service candidates should invariably apply through proper channel. Applications submitted directly without proper channel will be summarily rejected.
- (iii) Candidates can apply for more than one post in one application only.

## 4. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- ❖ Written test and interview will be conducted.
- ❖ The questions in written test will be both objective and descriptive.
- ❖ The duration of the examination will be 2 ½ hours.
- ❖ Centre of examination, date and time will be intimated in the Hall Ticket.
- ❖ A skill test will be conducted to the candidates who apply for the post of Assistant Programme Officer and Assistant Statistical Officer in addition to written test and interview.
